

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TO: DEFENDANT BLAKE CHARLES KEOKEOKALANI

It is the ORDER OF THE COURT that during your term of probation, you shall comply in all respects with the following terms and conditions:

1. You must obey all law and follow all lawful and reasonable instructions which are given to you by your probation officer.
2. You must report as directed by your probation officer.
3. You must report any change of address or change of employment within 48 hours.
4. You must not leave the island of Hawaii at any time without first obtaining permission from your probation officer.
5. You must permit your probation officer to visit your home and place of employment at all reasonable times.
6. Your further SPECIAL conditions of probation are as follows:

NOTE: If your whereabouts become unknown to your probation officer because of your failure to keep him informed, the court may order your arrest. Any failure by you to comply with all of the terms and conditions of probation will mean that the court can revoke your probation and sentence you to prison, or change or add to the terms of probation.

The foregoing terms and conditions of probation have been explained to me and I fully understand them and agree to abide by them in every way, and understand the consequences. I have received a copy of these terms and conditions of probation.

Further Special Conditions - Continued

- A. You shall be committed to the custody of the Director of the Department of Public Safety for incarceration for a period of six (6) months with all but sixty (60) days suspended. You shall be allowed to serve the time on an intermittent basis based on written clearance from your primary doctor. However, the 60 days shall be served not later than 56 months from October 13, 2000.
- B. You shall refrain from the use and/or possession of illegal or unprescribed drugs and alcohol.
- C. You shall be subject to random testing of your blood, breath and/or urine for the presence of illegal and/or unprescribed drugs and/or alcohol and shall present yourself for testing within two (2) hours of any request by your probation officer.
- D. Within sixty (6) days of October 13, 2000, you shall obtain a complete psychophysiological examination as approved by your probation officer and shall abide by all recommendations of that examination until successful clinical discharge. Should the examination recommend your attendance in sex offender treatment, you shall enter into the Transition Network Sex Offender Program within 30 days of receipt of the recommendation and shall abide by all program conditions/recommendations until successful clinical discharge. This includes any further polygraph/plethysmograph testing at your own expense.
- E. You shall waive all confidentiality between yourself, medical physician, sex offender treatment provider and your probation officer.
- F. You shall have no direct or indirect contact with any female child under the age of 18 without the expressed permission of your sex offender treatment provider and your probation officer.
- G. You shall have no direct or indirect contact with the victim.
- H. You shall register as a sex offender within forty-eight (48) hours of sentencing with the Hawaii County Police Department and shall be subject to DNA blood samples pursuant to law.
- I. You shall not frequent any establishment where unsupervised minor females may congregate. This includes movie theaters, arcades, carnivals and sports events.

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Further Special Conditions - Cont'd

- J. You shall provide written proof of your disability to your probation officer every six (6) months for the duration of your probationary period. In the event that you are no longer found to be disabled, you shall obtain full-time employment within thirty (30) days and shall remain employed throughout your probationary period unless you are later found to be disabled.
