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TO: DEFENDANT JOHN NITO DIAS, JR.

It is the ORDER OF THE COURT that during your term of probation, you shall comply in all respects with the following terms and conditions:

1. You must obey all law and follow all lawful and reasonable instructions which are given to you by your probation officer.
2. You must report as directed by your probation officer.
3. You must report any change of address or change of employment within 48 hours.
4. You must not leave the island of Oahu at any time without first obtaining permission from your probation officer.
5. You must permit your probation officer to visit your home and place of employment at all reasonable times.
6. Your further SPECIAL conditions of probation are as follows:

- a. You are committed to the custody of the Director of the Department of Social Services and Housing for incarceration for a period of THREE MONTHS. Mittimus to issue forthwith.
- b. Upon your release from incarceration, you shall obtain and maintain mental health treatment/services, including medication and/or tests if ordered, until clinically discharged with the concurrence of the Adult Probation Division; and
- c. You shall obtain and maintain gainful, full-time employment and/or educational/vocational training throughout period of probation.
- d. You shall secure a General Education Degree.

NOTE: If your whereabouts become unknown to your probation officer because of your failure to keep him informed, the court may order your arrest. Any failure by you to comply with all of the terms and conditions of probation will mean that the court can revoke your probation and sentence you to prison, or change or add to the terms of probation.

The foregoing terms and conditions of probation have been explained to me and I fully understand them and agree to abide by them in every way, and understand the consequences. I have received a copy of these terms and conditions of probation.



The Defendant entered the plea(s) indicated. It is adjudged that the Defendant has been convicted of and is guilty of the offense stated above, committed in the manner and form set forth in the charge.

The court finds that the Defendant comes within the classification of a young adult defendant under HRS Section 667 and that in lieu of any other sentence of imprisonment authorized by law, defendant should be sentenced to a special indeterminate term of imprisonment. The court is of the opinion that such special term is adequate for defendant's correction and rehabilitation and will not jeopardize the protection of the public.
