

The court finds that the Defendant comes within the classification of a young adult defendant under HRS Section 667 and that in lieu of any other sentence of imprisonment authorized by law, defendant should be sentenced to a special indeterminate term of imprisonment. The court is of the opinion that such special term is adequate for defendant's correction and rehabilitation and will not jeopardize the protection of the public.

FINAL JUDGMENT AND SENTENCE OF THE COURT:

COUNTS 1, 2, 6, 10: Life with the possibility of parole.
COUNTS 3, 4, 8, 9, 11: Ten (10) years indeterminate until
released in accordance with the law.
COUNT 5: Twenty (20) years indeterminate until
released in accordance with the law.
COUNTS 7, 12, 13: Life with the possibility of parole.

All terms to run concurrent with each other.

RESTITUTION:

COUNTS 1 - 5: \$292.00
COUNTS 6 - 12: 476.17

Matter of payment to be handled and determined by the Hawaii
Paroling Authority.

CREDIT FOR TIME SERVED:
