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FURTHER SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF PROBATION
HEARING DATE: 5/6/96 (Page 1 of 2)

- A. follow all reasonable instructions which are given to you by your probation officer;
- B. be committed to the custody of the Director of the Department of Public Safety for a period of SIX (6) MONTHS of jail confinement, with credit for time already served;
- C. obtain and maintain gainful, full-time employment and/or educational/vocational training as approved by the Adult Probation Division throughout the period of probation except as precluded by treatment;
- D. perform 400 hours of community service, to commence by 7/1/96 and to be completed by 7/1/98;
- E. refrain from the possession/consumption of alcohol and/or illicit/unprescribed drugs/substances;
- F. submit to drug and/or alcohol testing at your own expense as directed by the Adult Probation Division, with the provision that a positive finding and/or a failure to provide a specimen within two hours of instruction may be considered prima facie evidence of probation violation;
- G. based on reasonable suspicion that illicit substances or other contraband, that may include inappropriate materials as clinically defined by your therapist, may be in the places of a search, submit at reasonable times to a search of your person, residence, vehicle or other sites and property under your control, by any probation officer, with or without a warrant, and that any illicit substances or contraband found or observed thereby may be seized;
- H. obtain and maintain mental health treatment/services, including medication and/or tests if ordered, as deemed appropriate/necessary by the Adult Probation Division, and if so directed, remain in treatment until clinically discharged with the concurrence of the Adult Probation Division and anger management class, until clinically discharged;
- I. not make or attempt to make contact, directly or indirectly, with the victim or any other party significantly related to the victim, without the prior knowledge and authorization of the Adult Probation Division;

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- J. sign a Waiver of Extradition;
- K. participate satisfactorily in the Hawaii Sex Offender Treatment Program (HSOTP) with the provision that you obtain and maintain sex offender treatment, as approved by the Adult Probation Division (APD), at your own expense until clinically discharged with the concurrence of the APD; monthly progress reports are to be submitted to the APD by the therapist. If deemed by the APD to be financially unable to pay, you shall participate in treatment by the Judiciary contracted therapist with payment to be made in accordance with the APD payment formula;
- L. submit to electronic monitoring as deemed appropriate by the Adult Probation Division and as prescribed by the HSOTP, to be paid at your own expense;
- M. refrain from purchasing or possessing inappropriate audio or visual materials as clinically defined by your primary therapist; nor shall you frequent any place where such material is available to you;
- N. abide by curfew, travel and leisure time restrictions imposed by the APD;
- O. refrain from hitchhiking and picking up hitchhikers;
- P. obtain and/or maintain residence as approved by the APD.
