



TO: DEFENDANT: DAVID PAUL SALEMME

IT IS THE ORDER OF THE COURT THAT DURING YOUR TERM OF PROBATION, YOU SHALL COMPLY IN ALL RESPECTS WITH THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. You must not commit another federal or state crime during the term of probation;
2. You must report to a probation officer as directed by the court or the probation officer;
3. You must remain within the jurisdiction of the court unless granted permission to leave by the court or a probation officer;
4. You must notify a probation officer prior to any change in address or employment;
5. You must notify a probation officer promptly if arrested or questioned by a law enforcement officer; and
6. You must permit a probation officer to visit you at your home or elsewhere as specified by the court.
7. Your further special conditions of probation are as follows:
  - A. Follow all reasonable instructions which are given to you by your probation officer;

**Note:** IF YOUR WHEREABOUTS BECOME UNKNOWN TO YOUR PROBATION OFFICER BECAUSE OF YOUR FAILURE TO KEEP HIM INFORMED, THE COURT MAY ORDER YOUR ARREST. ANY FAILURE BY YOU TO COMPLY WITH ALL OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PROBATION WILL MEAN THAT THE COURT CAN REVOKE YOUR PROBATION AND SENTENCE YOU TO PRISON, OR CHANGE OR ADD TO THE TERMS OF PROBATION. YOU ARE FURTHER INFORMED THAT PER HRS 134-7, YOU ARE PROHIBITED FROM OWNING OR POSSESSING ANY FIREARM OR AMMUNITION.

THE FOREGOING TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PROBATION HAVE BEEN EXPLAINED TO ME; I FULLY UNDERSTAND THEM, AGREE TO ABIDE BY THEM IN EVERY WAY AND UNDERSTAND THE CONSEQUENCES. I HAVE RECEIVED A COPY OF THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PROBATION.

ATTACHMENT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- A. Follow all reasonable instructions which are given to you by your Probation Officer.
- B. You shall be placed under Home Detention for a period of SIXTY (60) DAYS and be subject to Electronic Monitoring as arranged by the Adult Probation Division.
- C. You must obtain and maintain gainful (full-time) employment and/or educational/vocational training throughout the period of probation.
- D. You must perform 200 hours of community service at a rate of not less than 20 hours per month, to commence within 30 days after your home detention has been completed and to be completed within twelve months thereafter.
- E. You must not make or attempt to make contact, directly or indirectly, with the victim or any other party significantly related to the victim, without the prior knowledge and authorization of the Probation Officer.
- F. You must provide a written waiver of confidentiality for any assessment, treatment, counseling or therapy.
- G. You must submit to a psychosexual assessment with a certified sex offender counselor and if treatment is recommended, maintain treatment until clinically discharged with the concurrence of the Adult Probation Division.
- H. You must write a letter of apology to the victim within thirty days, as approved by the Adult Probation Division. Return day set for March 13, 2001 at 8 a.m.
- I. You must abide by any curfew, travel and leisure time restrictions imposed by the Adult Probation Division.
- J. You must reimburse the Judiciary for any assessment and/or treatment paid by the Judiciary as determined by the Adult Probation Division.
- K. You must not own/possess/have in your control any type of firearm and/or ammunition.
- L. You must sign a Waiver of Extradition.

- M. You must pay the Crime Victim Compensation fee in the amount of \$200.00.
- N. You must pay the Probation fee in the amount of \$150.00.
- O. You must pay the Crime Victim Compensation fee and Probation fee at the rate of at least \$100.00 per month commencing 30 days after completion of your Home Detention period with the Crime Victim Compensation fee being satisfied first and then the Probation Services fee.
- P. You must not work as a massage therapist for the duration of your probation.
- Q. You must submit to blood and saliva samples pursuant to HRS Section 706-603 and report to the Maui Police Department Crime Laboratory for March 13, 2001 at 9 a.m.
- R. You must register as a sex offender.
- S. You must appear on March 13, 2001 at 8 a.m. for Return Day on Status of Surrendering Your Massage Therapy License.
