


The Defendant entered a plea(s) indicated. It is adjudged that the Defendant has been convicted of and is guilty of the offense stated above, committed in the manner and form set forth in the charge.

The court finds that the Defendant comes with the classification of a young adult defendant under HRS Section 667 and that in lieu of any other sentence of imprisonment authorized by law, defendant should be sentenced to a special indeterminate term of imprisonment. The court is of the opinion that such special term is adequate for defendant's correction and rehabilitation and will not jeopardize the protection of the public.

AS TO COUNTS 1 - 10 & 18: SEXUAL ASSAULT IN THE SECOND DEGREE:

- A. You shall be confined in prison for a period of 10 (ten) years as to each count, to run concurrently, with credit for time served; mittimus to issue forthwith.
- B. You shall pay a \$2,255.00 Crime Victim Compensation fee (\$205.00 for each count).
- C. You shall provide buccal swab samples and print impressions of each hand, and, if required by the collecting agency's rules or internal regulations, blood specimens, required for law enforcement identification purposes.
- D. You shall pay for the actual cost of the DNA analysis to the DNA registry fund.
- E. You shall provide two samples of blood for DNA analysis within 30 days to be arranged by the Department of Public Safety.
