FINAL JUDGMENT AND SENTENCE OF THE COURT:

1. You are committed to the custody of the Director of Public Safety as follows: Counts 1, 2 & 7: Five (5) years each. Counts 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 & 10: Ten (10) years each. All counts to run concurrently with each other with credit for time served from March 9, 1995. Mittimus to issue forthwith.
2. You shall provide a sample of your blood and/or saliva for DNA testing and analysis to the Hawaii Police Department (HPD) pursuant to Section 706-603.
3. You shall register with the HPD as a sex offender.
4. You shall not possess, use or own, sell or have under your control any firearm, ammunition, or any other destructive device.
